4-21-19 Small Group Questions

Getting Going (15 mins)

1. Settling In & Opening Prayer
2. What was the best part of your week? Worst?

Digging Deeper (40 mins)

1. Review: What stood out the most from your small group Good Friday observance this past week?
2. Do you believe Job was a real person? Why or why not? Is it important?
3. Job's life exemplified much of the very worst of the suffering this life can bring. If you are willing to share, in what ways have you felt a little like Job?
4. The most famous use of the word translated "Redeemer" in Job 19:25 comes from the book of Ruth where Boaz is the Kinsmen Redeemer (Ruth 2:20). Take a few minutes to refresh your memory to the story of Ruth. How do the actions of Boaz point forward to the work of our Kinsmen Redeemer, Jesus Christ?
5. Jesus is our Kinsmen, our Vindicator, our Redeemer. How does this knowledge bring you hope in a world of suffering?

Practical Preparation (10 mins)

1. How will the way you live your life this week be influenced by the hopeful reminder that Jesus is your living Kinsmen, Vindicator and Redeemer?
2. Who do you know that needs to be encouraged by this message? Will you commit to sharing it with them?
