# Digging Deeper (40 mins)

- 1. Review: What stood out the most from your small group Good Friday observance this past week?
- 2. Do you believe Job was a real person? Why or why not? Is it important?
- 3. Job's life exemplified much of the very worst of the suffering this life can bring. If you are willing to share, in what ways have you felt a little like Job?
- 4. The most famous use of the word translated "Redeemer" in Job 19:25 comes from the book of Ruth where Boaz is the Kinsmen Redeemer (Ruth 2:20). Take a few minutes to refresh your memory to the story of Ruth. How do the actions of Boaz point forward to the work of our Kinsmen Redeemer, Jesus Christ?
- 5. Jesus is our Kinsmen, our Vindicator, our Redeemer. How does this knowledge bring you hope in a world of suffering?

#### <u>Practical Preparation</u> (10 mins)

- 1. How will the way you live your life this week be influenced by the hopeful reminder that Jesus is your living Kinsmen, Vindicator and Redeemer?
- 2. Who do you know that needs to be encouraged by this message? Will you commit to sharing it with them?
