4-15-18 Small Group Questions

Getting Going (15 mins)

1. Settling in & Opening Prayer
2. My favorite non-biblical proverb is “Better to remain silent and assumed a fool then to open your mouth and remove all doubt.” What’s yours?

Digging Deeper (35 mins)

1. Review: As we learned last week, the Great Commission consists of *going*, *making* and *teaching*. Were you able to put effort toward any of the 3 this past week?
2. Who is the wisest person you know? How do they demonstrate wisdom?
3. It seems like many people today (not you of course!) are quite happy to stay foolish. Why do you suppose this is?
4. Proverbs repeatedly states that the “fear of the Lord” is the beginning of wisdom/knowledge. Why is this true?
5. Using a concordance, find and read 7 verses with the word “wisdom” (or its derivative) in them. What else can we learn about wisdom from these verses?

Practical Preparation (10 mins)

1. Are you wise? What could you do to increase in wisdom?
2. What area of life do you need wisdom in this next week?
