1. Settling In & Opening Prayer
2. What season of the year is your favorite? Why?

Digging Deeper (40 mins)

1. Review: Last week Noel taught us that we have a Real Hope for a Real Salvation, a Real Inheritance, and a Real Joy. Which of these hopes was most meaningful for you this past week? Why?
2. Read 1 Peter 1:13-2:3. What stands out to you as you read this passage?
3. According to this passage, why is it that we should hope fully in Christ?
4. This passage also teaches us to fear God. Why is that important?
5. THE distinguishing mark of a Christian is love for the church family (see John 13:35). How do we do this (1 Pt. 1:22; 2:1)? Give some practical examples of how this should look.
6. What happens to a newborn that does not get milk? What happens to a Christian who does not take in the Word? How often does a newborn feed? How often do you take in the Word?

2. As a result of this motivation, what are the 2 Actions of Holiness?
